APPENDIX 1

Function Codes

The automated NAMSA Source File System will include per activity of the supplier a 2 digit “Function Code” in order to indicate the function of the supplier with respect to the supplies or services or any combination thereof as follows:

SUPPLY	1 st Digit
Manufacturer, original (designed the item)	M
Manufacturer, alternate source (reproduces item designed elsewhere)	A
Dealer, regular (appointed distributor for manufacturer) holding own stock of newly produced item	D
Dealer, non-regular (distributor without appointment by manufacturer) holding own stock of <u>newly</u> produced material	N
Dealer, non-regular (distributor) holding own stocks of surplus material	S
Representative nominated by original manufacturer or alternate source, as their sales outlet, not holding own stocks	R
Broker (not appointed distributor of manufacturer) not holding stocks	B
Services only	Z
